 - A. Comments from LAPD SLO

LAPD SLO Kwon Villery addressed the Board and described current crime trends in the district as well as actions that LAPD was taking in response. He also described LAPD's toy giveaway project for needy children at Christmas. The Board and Villery engaged in an open discussion.

- 5. BUSINESS ITEMS
 - A. Report from CD11 re Manchester Square Homeless Issues & Construction Schedule
 - Omar Pulido, LAX Liaison in CD11

Omar Pulido of CD11 provided an overview of development plans for the future of the Manchester Square area and efforts underway to manage the homeless issues which are prevalent at that site. Approximately 150-200 homeless are currently encamped at the site. Construction at that location of the new consolidated rental car facility is scheduled to commence in January 2018. The City goal is to bring about the transition with the least amount of homeless displacement, which means that focused solutions need to be applied.

The Board had an extended discussion about the issue. No action was taken.

B. Report from CD11 re Revised On-Street Parking Restrictions- Anna Kozma, Westchester Deputy in CD11

Anna Kozma, Westchester Field Deputy of CD11 described efforts that the Council Office was undertaking to address homeless issuse in the district. Councilman Bonin is a leading advocate for developing housing facilities for the homeless. There is a potential for using the abandoned firehouse on Manchester as either a site for new construction of homeless housing or a source of revenue for such construction elsewhere. Councilman Bonin is also advocating for overnight camping use for parking lots at churches, parks, and other places.

The Board Members and Anna Kozma engaged in a general discussion of homeless issues. No action was taken.

- C. Recommendation for Establishment of "No Overnight Parking" Zone on Sepulveda Between 92nd and Manchester
 - MyDOT Service Request #69317 (Oct 27, 2016)

The Executive Director reported on the requested establishment of a "No Overnight Parking" zone along Sepulveda between 92nd Street and Manchester Avenue.

After discussion, Motion Lemmon 2nd Ruhlen: "The WBIA Board of Directors hereby endorses the creation of the requested restricted parking zone." Unanimously approved.
